

The sources for and process used in making *The Way of the Cross* by Theodore Prescott. A similar sign could be made to give to the Vatican Museum.

Left side: *The Way of the Cross II*, 2011, 26" sq., aluminum sign. I designed this piece which was fabricated by a commercial sign company. It is the same as road signs like the "cross road" sign shown on the **Right Side**. However, *The Way of the Cross II* has a generic black Latin cross as its "sign". It was shot by a friend who hunts, using different caliber guns.



The two images below show what is often seen in rural areas of the U.S. Hunters and others with guns shoot at signs. Sometimes that is to express displeasure with the stated regulations and warnings. Other times people shoot signs just to destroy things, or to "have fun" with a ready-made target.



The Way of the Cross II calls attention to the attitudes through which we see. With regard to this cross, there is no neutral way of seeing it as simply a "sign". It displays the responses of someone looking from a particular perspective. **Should the Vatican be interested in one for their collection, I will make one. I have no available versions. It might be possible for me to make it in Italy, where I will be teaching this fall.**
